




Please be mindful when parking in and around the school.

	<p>ANTI BULLYING AND EXPECTATIONS</p> <p>In June, we introduced our Expectation Policy with the children. This replaced our behaviour policy.</p> <p>We ask children to follow the three R's – Respect, Resilience and Responsibility. Children are asked to use the phrase 'Stop it, I don't like it' in response to their peers doing something they do not like with their peers being asked to respect everyone's choices. Staff ask the children 'Is it kind?' 'Is it safe?' 'Is it right?' when addressing any incidents.</p> <p>Please do encourage your children to use this language if they report an issue to you and also encourage them to raise it with an adult in school so it can be addressed 'in the moment' and not the following day.</p> <p>When learning and discussing bullying, we teach children 'S.T.O.P.' Several Times On Purpose. Again, please use this with your children as this helps build a better understanding, builds resilience and also supports the children as they move on to secondary school and face new challenges.</p>
	<p>MATHS FLEX AND MATHS JAM</p> <p>Maths Flex and Maths Jam are in the process of being set up for KS1 and KS2.</p> <p>As soon as these are up and running, the children will receive their passwords and be able to access these platforms.</p> <p>Thank you for your patience.</p>
