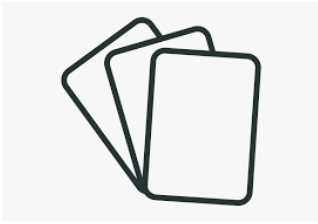
The children were a joy to be with albeit rather too eager to soak the staff as soon as they had a chance to!

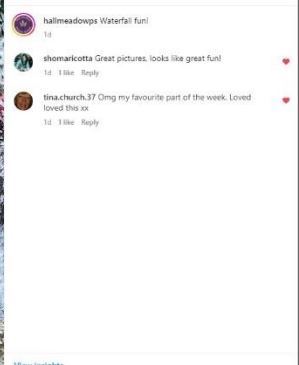
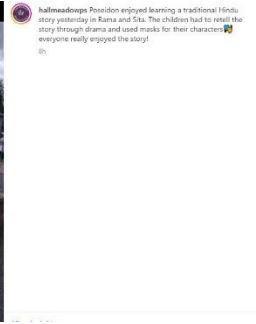
