Dear Parents/Carers,

The first term has flown by!

We have had a great start to the term with visitors, virtual classes and school trips including Cadbury World yesterday. The children have settled so well into their new school year and external school improvement visits have confirmed that learning continues to be at least good across the school.

On Thursday, the national comparative data was published for our school. Hall Meadow is in the top percentile (100th) for both Yr1 phonics and KS2 grammar, punctuation and spelling. We are significantly above the national average at the end of Key Stage 2 (this is the SATs data that are externally marked and moderated). This really is down to the children, staff and the home school communication which is key to ensure our children leave Hall Meadow ready for their next step. Huge congratulations and well done to everyone.

As the weather cools, the nights draw in and the heating goes on; take time to relax, enjoy the PACT Halloween trail and have a fantastic break.
