Join Kettering in helping Sebastian

Please wear orange and donate £1 if you are able to

All schools in Kettering have been invited to take part, in wear it **orange** day not just schools to join Brambleside school, working together as a community to raise the lifesaving funds Sebastian desperately needs.

The date for this community mufti day event is **Friday 10th November**.

As you may know, Sebastian, a 6 year old year 2 pupil at Brambleside School is suffering with Neuroblatoma, a rare type of childhood cancer that kills. The latest CT scan of his chest in September revealed new patches of disease. The family want to raise money so they can take up offers of treatment abroad after exhausting options in the UK. Sebastian's dad Gregg said: "We know that there is a programme at a hospital in Rome that, if Sebastian was accepted, we would need to find around £200,000 – so we need to fundraise as much as possible". The current fundraising stands at £74,200.

This community wide orange mufti day with schools and businesses will surely help Sebastian get closer to that target.

We invite your child to take part and come to school on 10th November. once again dressed in orange (or something bright). You may remember, Orange is Sebastian's favourite colour, so what better way to show our community support? A mufti day throughout Kettering will involve a high volume of children which in turn will generate hundreds of £1 coin donations to help us, as a community to reach Sebastian's fundraising target.

Sebastian has appeared on BBC news, ITV news and has also had articles in the Daily Mirror. His appeal features weekly in the Northamptonshire Evening Telegraph. Read this week's article by clicking below:

As part of our commitment to make maths exciting and high profile in our school, we are taking part in a friendly competition involving schools in England. The competition runs from 7:30am Tuesday 14th November 2023 to 7:30pm Thursday 16th November 2023. It's all done online via play.ttrockstars.com.

Children can play in any game mode with every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, earning themselves, their class and the school a point. The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average (the number of correct answers per pupil in the class who play during the competition hours, subject to a daily 60-minute limit (see below)). The top three boys and top three girls from each class will be awarded with a certificate in assembly

To support player wellbeing, there is a daily time limit of 60-minutes per player. In other words, each player can earn competition points for up to 60-minutes between 07:30 GMT and 19:30 GMT on 07:30 GMT Tuesday 14th November 2023 to 19:30 GMT Thursday 16th November 2023. Once the player goes beyond 60-minutes of play on that day, they will still earn coins but will no longer earn points towards the competition.

In the spirit of the competition, please don't play on their behalf but by all means encourage and support them to the extent that it doesn't cause high stress levels or impact on family plans.

On the first day of the competition (Tuesday 14th November) We would love for your child to come to school dressed as a ROCKSTAR!
