## **Attendance Matters**

## Our attendance this week is 93.9% (national average

We are having an increasing number of requests for term time holidays. Three families have already received penalty notice fines from the local authority. This money does not come to school; it goes directly to NNC. We have been in contact with the attendance team at NNC and at least one of our families is at risk of further action including a summons to court due to taking regular holidays in term time over last year and this year.

Whilst we appreciate holidays are expensive, a week off school can result in your child missing a whole unit in maths, reading and/or writing, a key science lesson, other key learning elements and school trips. Last year, some children missed key assessments including the national multiplication check. These records follow your child through school to secondary.

Attendance does matter. It is monitored closely and forms part of our regular safeguarding meetings which can escalate referrals through to other services including the Education Inclusion Officers for further investigations.

Please think about this when planning days out / holidays.
