## Well done Miss Letts!



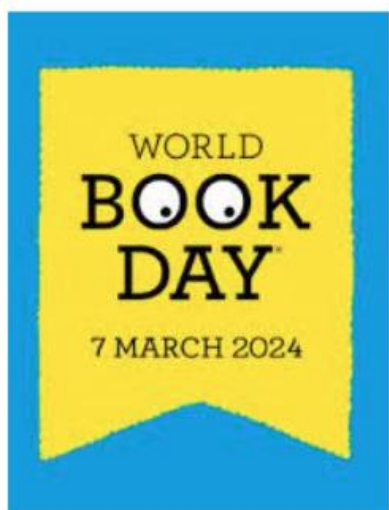
