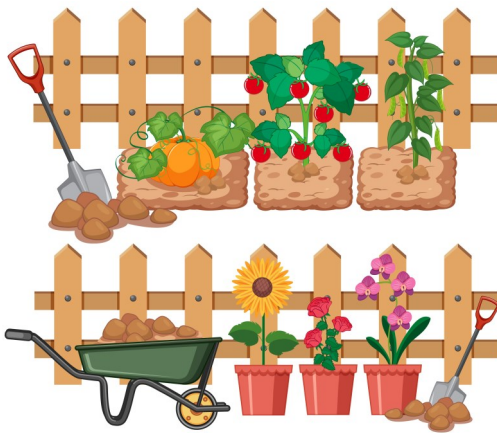

Gardening

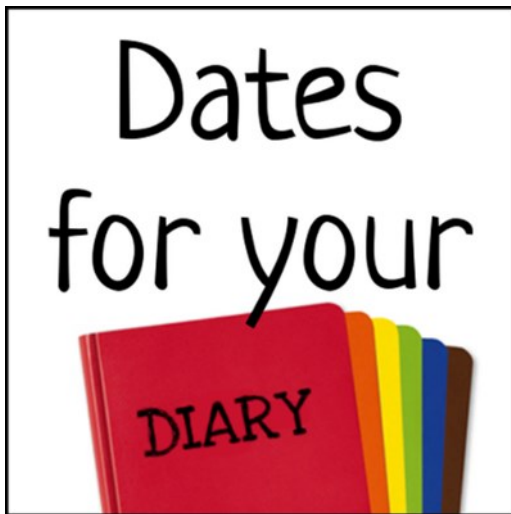
