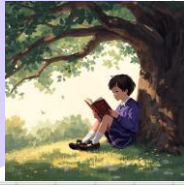

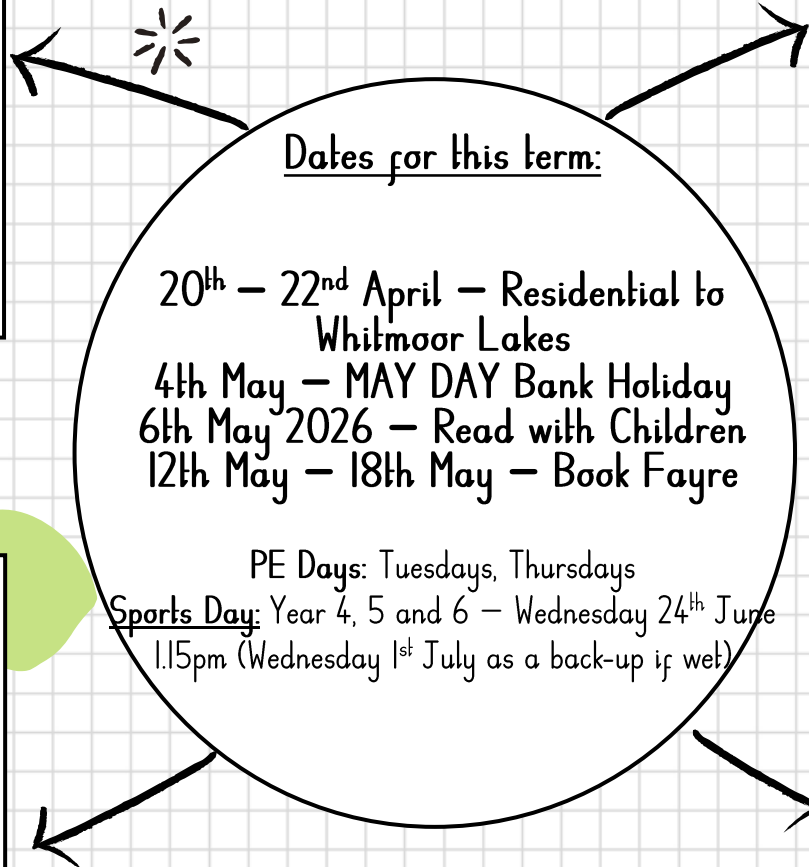
READING

WRITING

DATES AND INFORMATION:



Narrative: Aladdin: Fronted adverbials,, con junctions, direct speech, time adverbials, contractions, possessive apostrophes

Lost on the Platform. Fronted adverbials, commas in a list, contractions, direct speech, possessive apostrophes, subordinating and coordinating con junctions



MATHS

Decimals: round numbers to the nearest whole number, order decimals with the same number of decimal places, know and understand decimal equivalents of simple fractions such as a half and a quarter.

Money: record money using the £.p notation, convert between pounds and pence and vice versa, estimate totals when the price of an item, compare and order amounts of money, use the four operations to solve money-based problems

Time: convert between units of time, express times in both analogue and digital forms, including 24-hour clock times

SCIENCE

Living things and their habitats (conservation): Children will learn how to recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.



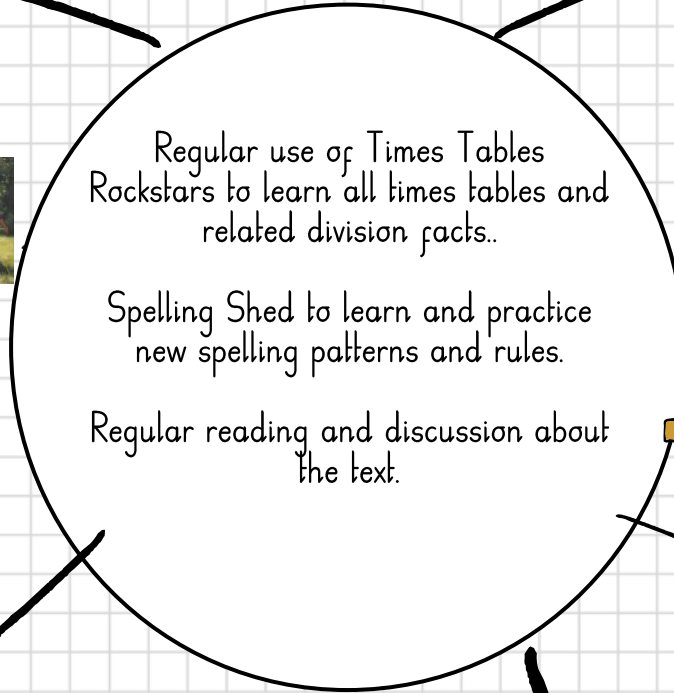
GEOGRAPHY
